Groundsure Review is a detailed commercial environmental due diligence report that contains all of the information in Groundsure Screening, but comes with a detailed assessment of environmental and flood risks as well as a review of all high detail mapping. Groundsure Review is ideal for use in commercial property acquisitions, associated funding arrangements and consideration of property suitability for inclusion within pension schemes.

What does it cover?

- Details on whether the site represents acceptable banking security from an environmental perspective
- Full contaminated land risk assessment covering essential Part 2A requirements
- Detailed flood risk opinion including river, coastal and surface water flooding plus historic flood events
- Natural hazards including natural ground subsidence and detailed radon potential.

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
